

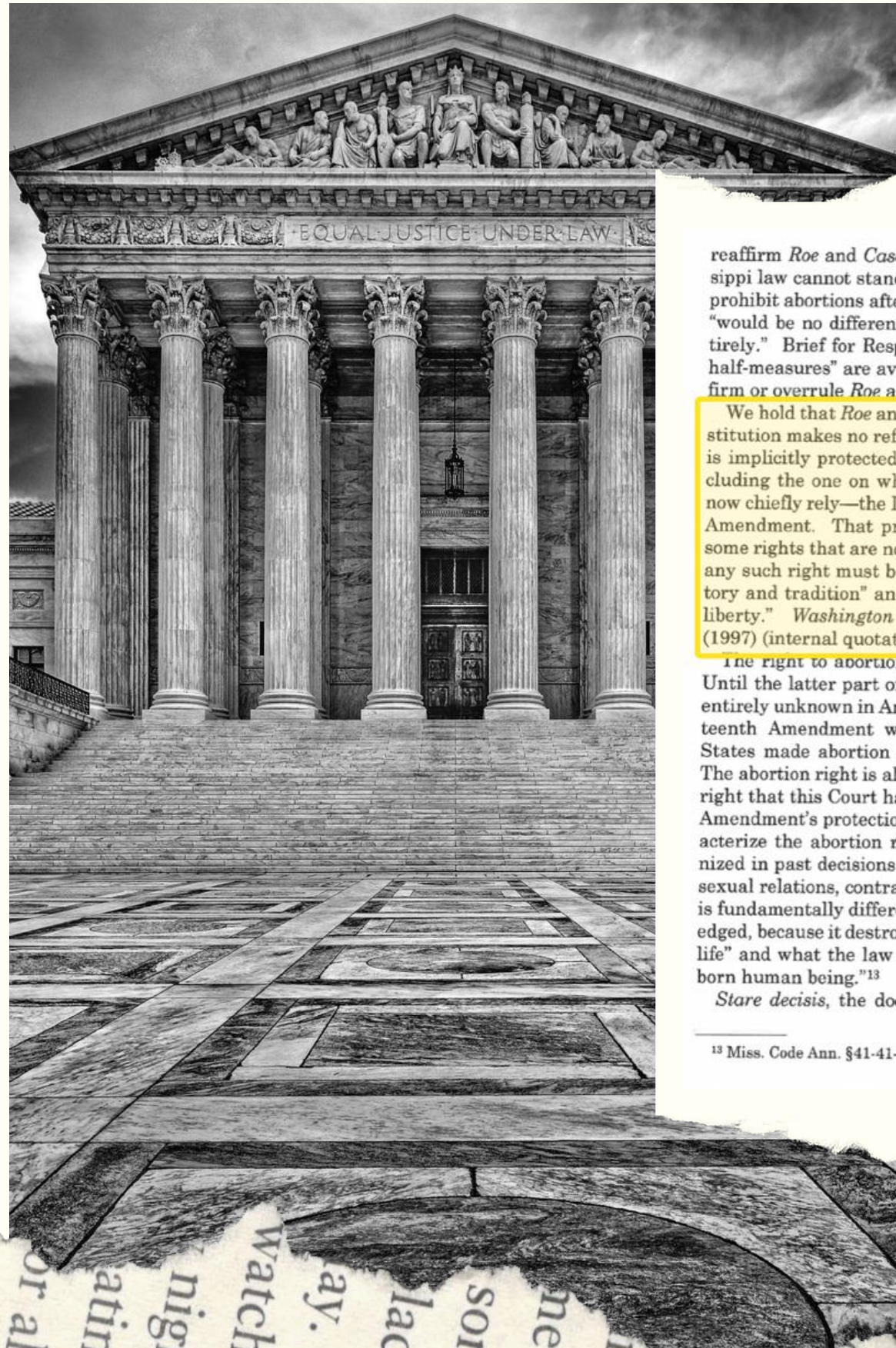

A BIBLICAL CASE FOR THE ABOLITION OF ABORTION:
A GOSPEL-CENTERED APPROACH





reaffirm *Roe* and *Casey*, and they contend that the Mississippi law cannot stand if we do so. Allowing Mississippi to prohibit abortions after 15 weeks of pregnancy, they argue, “would be no different than overruling *Casey* and *Roe* entirely.” Brief for Respondents 43. They contend that “no half-measures” are available and that we must either reaffirm or overrule *Roe* and *Casey*. *Id.* at 50.

We hold that *Roe* and *Casey* must be overruled. The Constitution makes no reference to abortion, and no such right is implicitly protected by any constitutional provision, including the one on which the defenders of *Roe* and *Casey* now chiefly rely—the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment. That provision has been held to guarantee some rights that are not mentioned in the Constitution, but any such right must be “deeply rooted in this Nation’s history and tradition” and “implicit in the concept of ordered liberty.” *Washington v. Glucksberg*, 521 U. S. 702, 721 (1997) (internal quotation marks omitted).

The right to abortion does not fall within this category. Until the latter part of the 20th century, such a right was entirely unknown in American law. Indeed, when the Fourteenth Amendment was adopted, three quarters of the States made abortion a crime at all stages of pregnancy. The abortion right is also critically different from any other right that this Court has held to fall within the Fourteenth Amendment’s protection of “liberty.” *Roe*’s defenders characterize the abortion right as similar to the rights recognized in past decisions involving matters such as intimate sexual relations, contraception, and marriage, but abortion is fundamentally different, as both *Roe* and *Casey* acknowledged, because it destroys what those decisions called “fetal life” and what the law now before us describes as an “unborn human being.”¹³

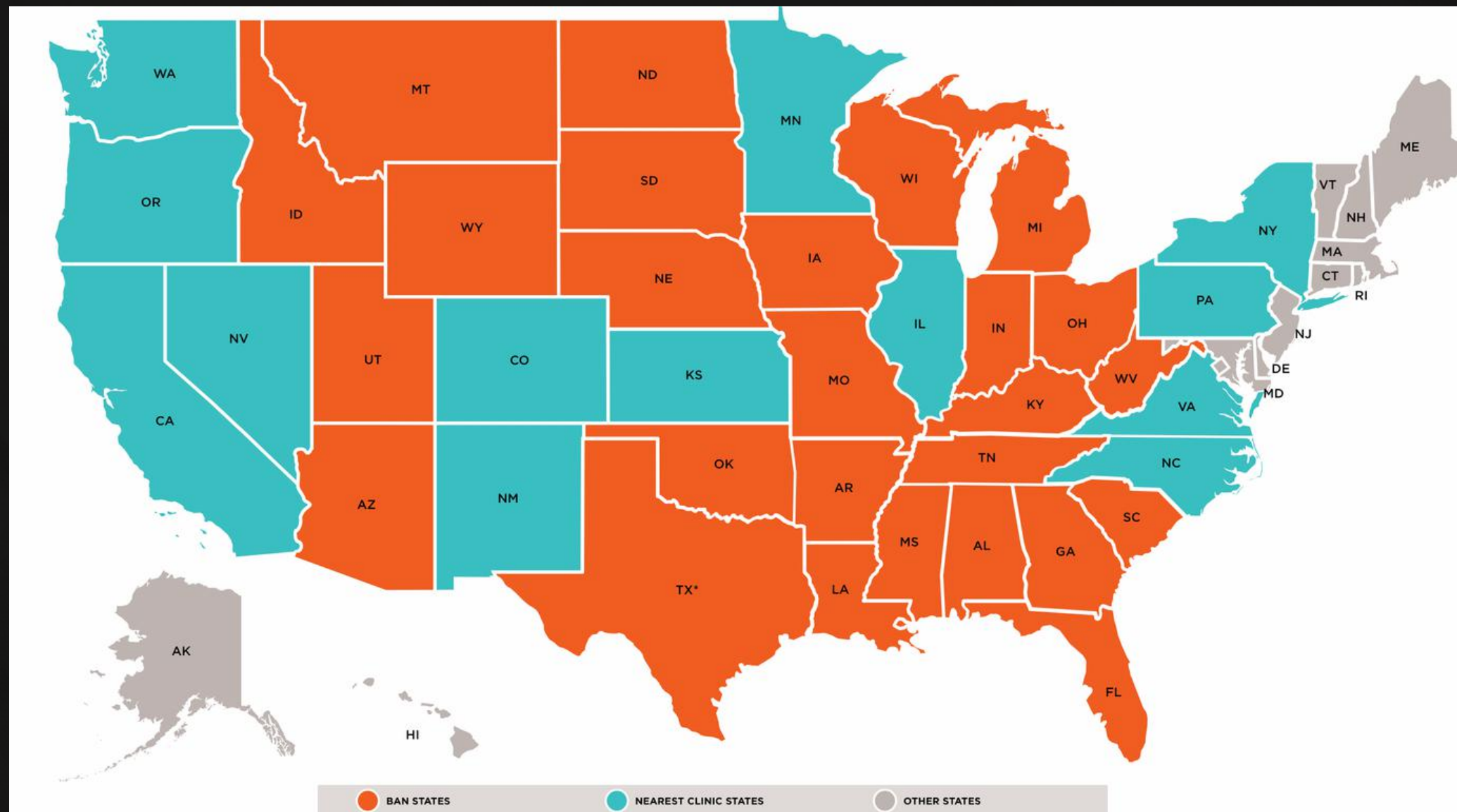
DOBBS V. JACKSON SUPREME COURT LEAK

Possibly Overturn:

- **Roe v. Wade**
- **Planned Parenthood v. Casey**

This will not result in a nationwide ban of abortions, but will place the matter under the jurisdiction of the states. Some states have pre-Roe bans that will now be honored. Others have "trigger" bans designed to go into effect when *Roe* is overturned. Others will potentially make similar bans. Sadly, others will double-down to facilitate child murder.

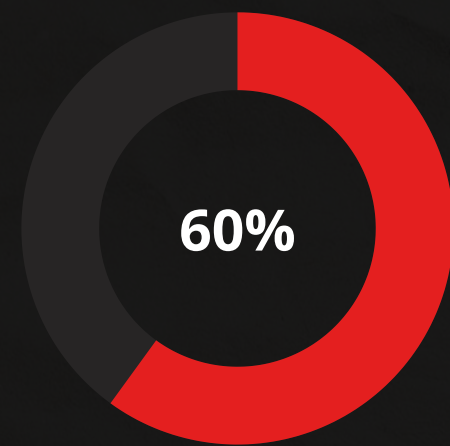
In short, the fight to rescue those being led to slaughter will not cease upon the overturn of Roe.

We are likely to see life states and death states with divisions similar to free and slave states before the Civil War. Balkanization is not out of the question.

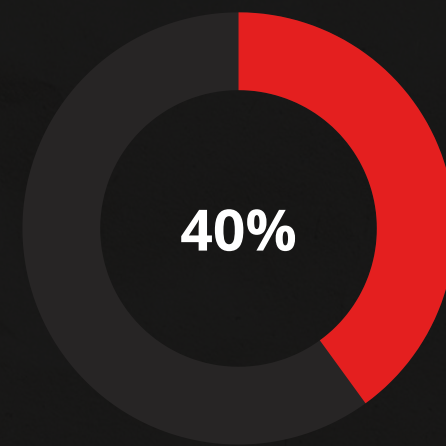

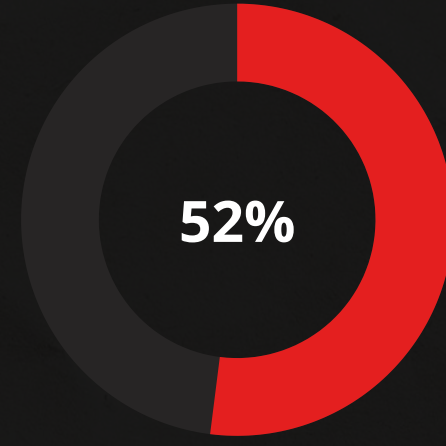

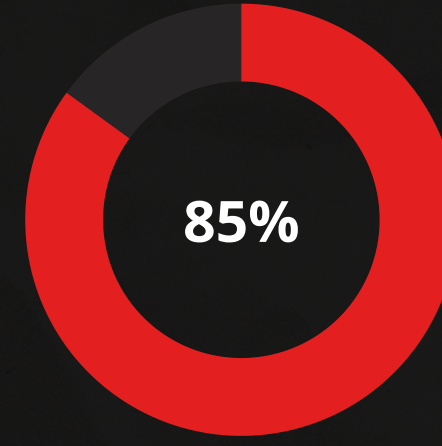

in His own image to glorify Him.



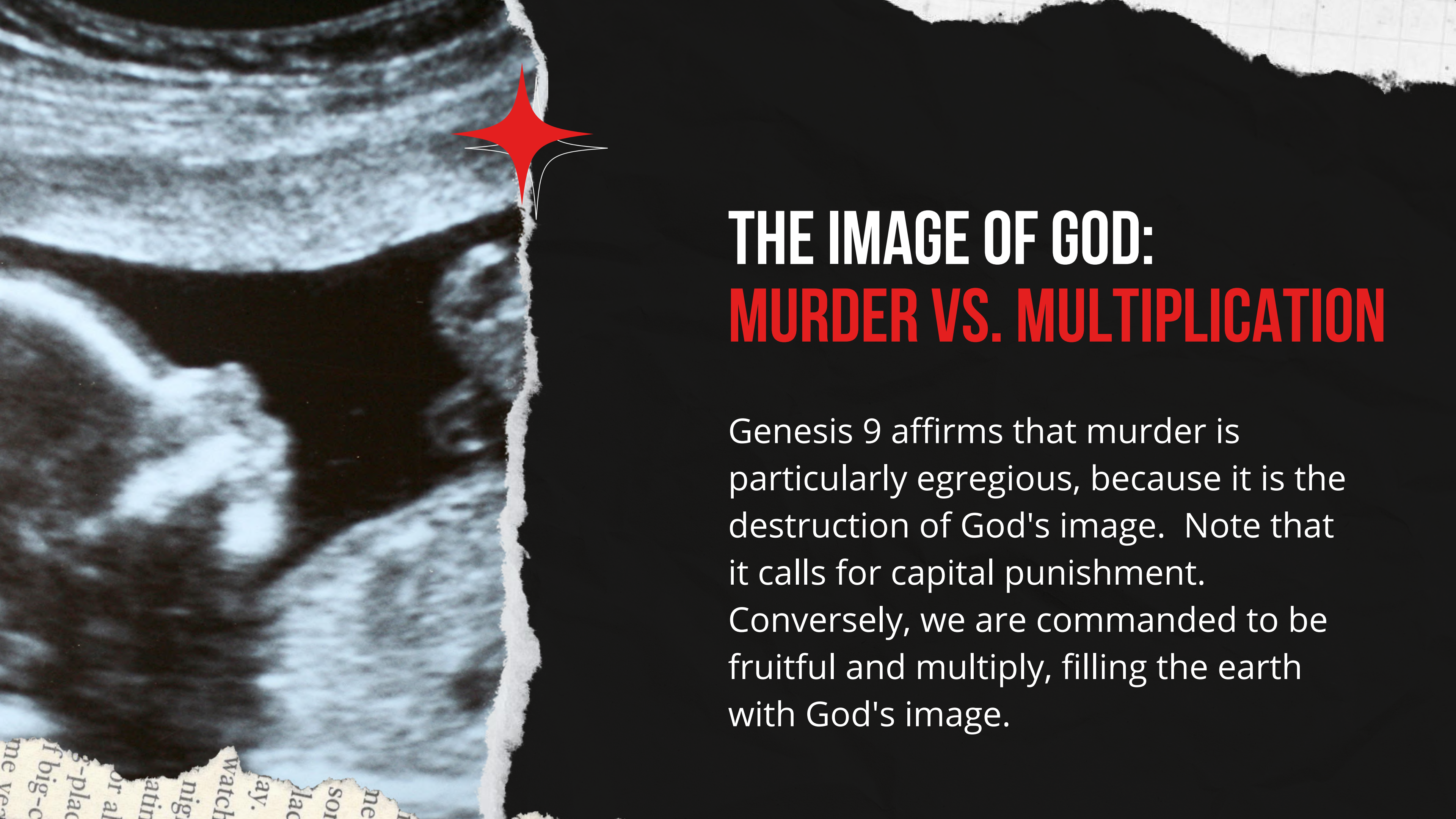
***5 And for your lifeblood I will require a reckoning:

THE IMAGE OF GOD: **MURDER VS. MULTIPLICATION**

Genesis 9 affirms that murder is particularly egregious, because it is the destruction of God's image. Note that it calls for capital punishment.

Conversely, we are commanded to be fruitful and multiply, filling the earth with God's image.



MURDER AND THE GOSPEL

PAGANISM AND INFANTICIDE

- Exodus 1:16-Infanticide is used to limit Hebrew population and keep them from fighting tyranny.
- Matthew 2:16 Infanticide is used in an attempt to kill the Messiah.
- 2 Kings 16:3 and 2 Chronicles 28:3 King Ahaz sacrificed his son in fire in a pagan ritual.
- 2 Kings 21:6 King Manasseh sacrificed his son in fire in pagan ritual.
- Ezekiel 20:30-31 God judges Israel for idolatry and the practice of child sacrifice.

-Proverbs 8:35-36



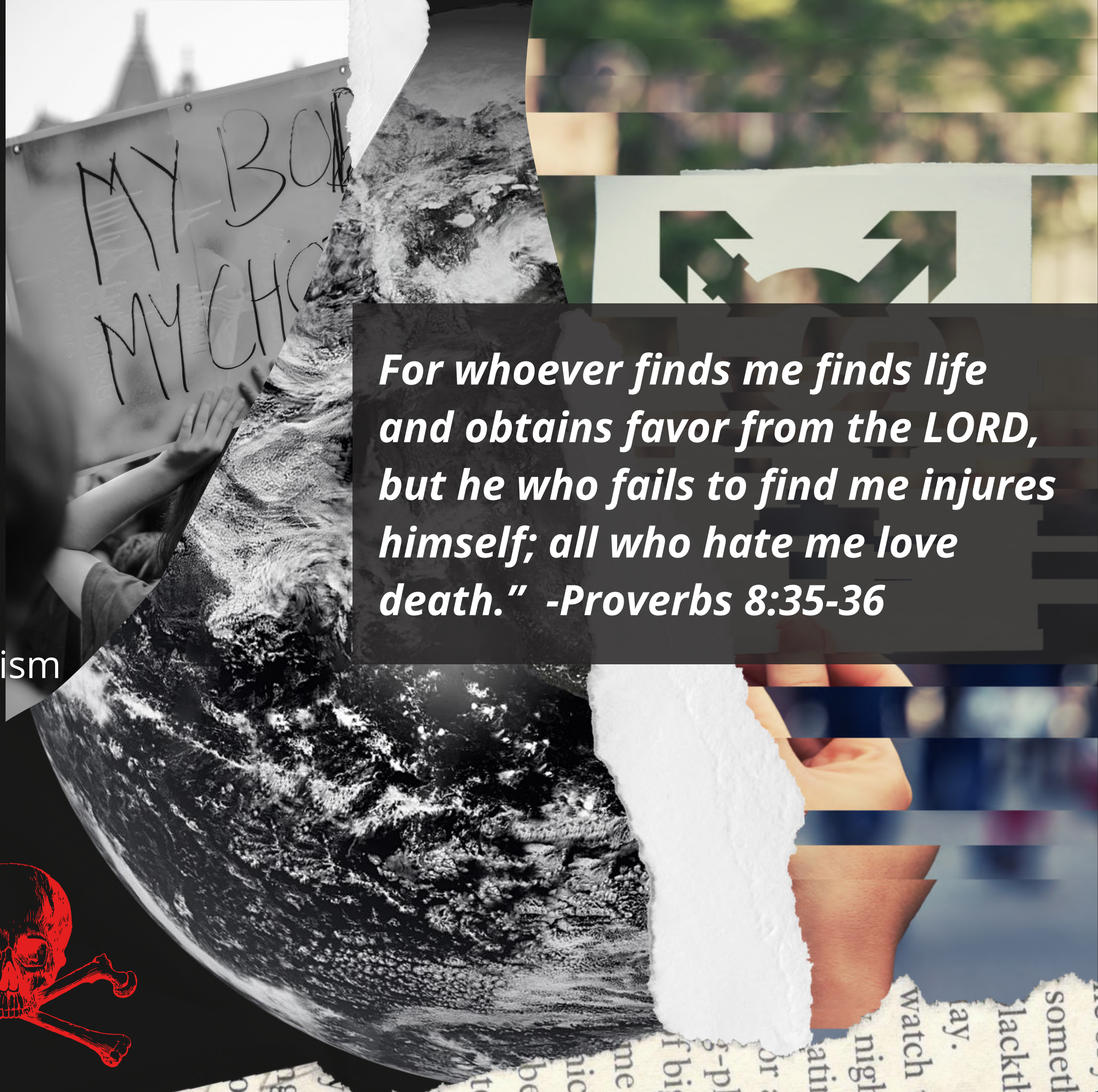

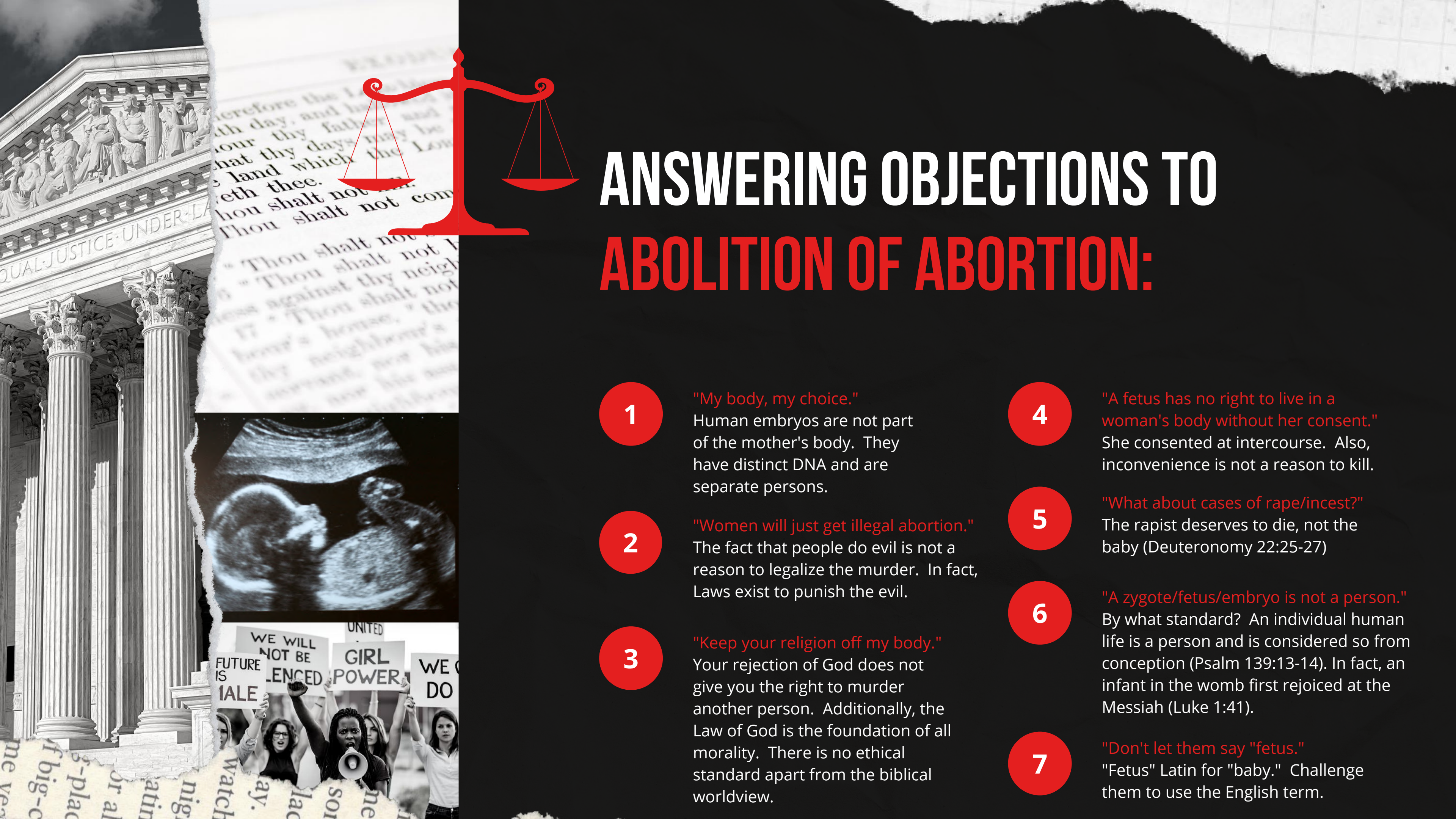

ANSWERING OBJECTIONS TO ABOLITION OF ABORTION:

1

"My body, my choice."

Human embryos are not part of the mother's body. They have distinct DNA and are separate persons.

2

"Women will just get illegal abortion."

The fact that people do evil is not a reason to legalize the murder. In fact, Laws exist to punish the evil.

3

"Keep your religion off my body."

Your rejection of God does not give you the right to murder another person. Additionally, the Law of God is the foundation of all morality. There is no ethical standard apart from the biblical worldview.

4

"A fetus has no right to live in a woman's body without her consent." She consented at intercourse. Also, inconvenience is not a reason to kill.

5

"What about cases of rape/incest?"

The rapist deserves to die, not the baby (Deuteronomy 22:25-27)

6

"A zygote/fetus/embryo is not a person."

By what standard? An individual human life is a person and is considered so from conception (Psalm 139:13-14). In fact, an infant in the womb first rejoiced at the Messiah (Luke 1:41).

7

"Don't let them say "fetus."

"Fetus" Latin for "baby." Challenge them to use the English term.



UNIVERSAL RESPONSE: "BY WHAT STANDARD?"

- Non-believers "borrow" ethics from Christianity. Don't let them appeal to right and wrong while denying the God who sets the standard.
- When challenged on abortion (or any other issue), respond with "by what standard?" This forces them to consider the fact that they inherently deny objective authority.
- Appeal to the fact that ethics and truth come from God and God alone (Proverbs 9:10)

SHOULD THE CHURCH ENGAGE IN THE POLITICAL ARENA?

- Yes, Jesus is Lord of All (Matthew 28:18).

- We are commanded to rescue those being led away to slaughter (Prov. 24).
- God hates evil laws and judges makers of evil laws. "Woe to those who decree iniquitous decrees." (Isaiah 10)
- Obedience to God trumps obedience to man (Acts 5:29).

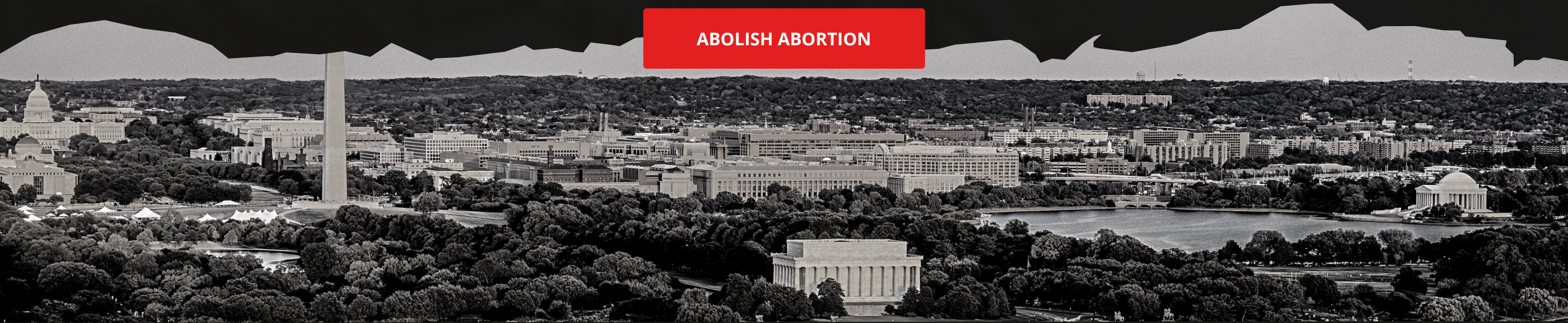

WHY ABOLITION OF ABORTION AND NOT "INCREMENTALISM"?

- God hates evil laws and judges makers of evil laws. "Woe to those who decree iniquitous decrees." (Isaiah 10)
- Unjust weights and measures are an abomination to God (Prov. 20:10). Laws that allow for the murder of some babies are unjust weights and measures.

WHAT ABOUT

SEPARATION OF CHURCH AND STATE?

- Jesus is Lord of All (Matthew 28:18). Civil authorities are HIS servants.
- Obedience to God trumps obedience to man (Acts 5:29).
- Civil authorities are servants of God not the other way around. Any human law that does not align with God's Law is no law at all (Romans 13:1-5)
- The "establishment clause" in the First Amendment prohibits the institution of a state church. It does not at all inhibit the infusion of biblical principles into the legislative process.

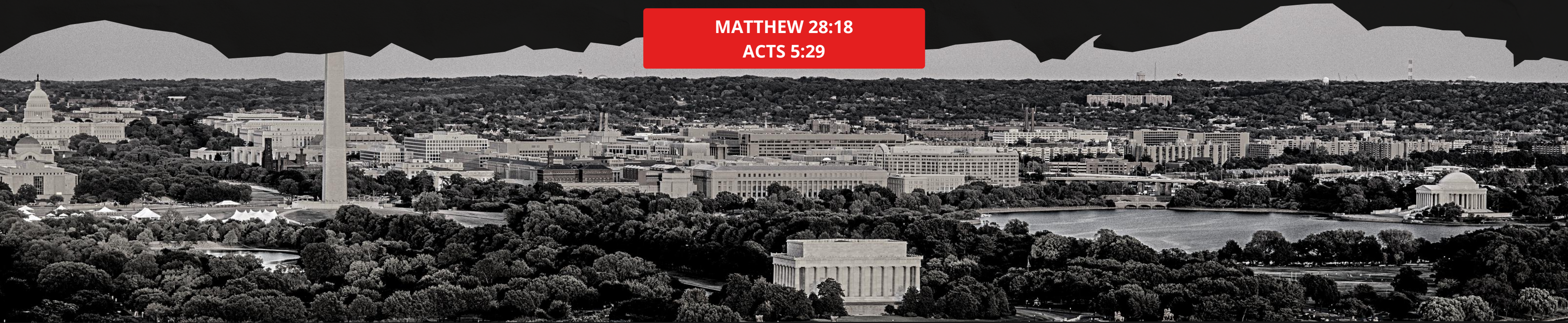
WHAT ABOUT ROMANS 13?

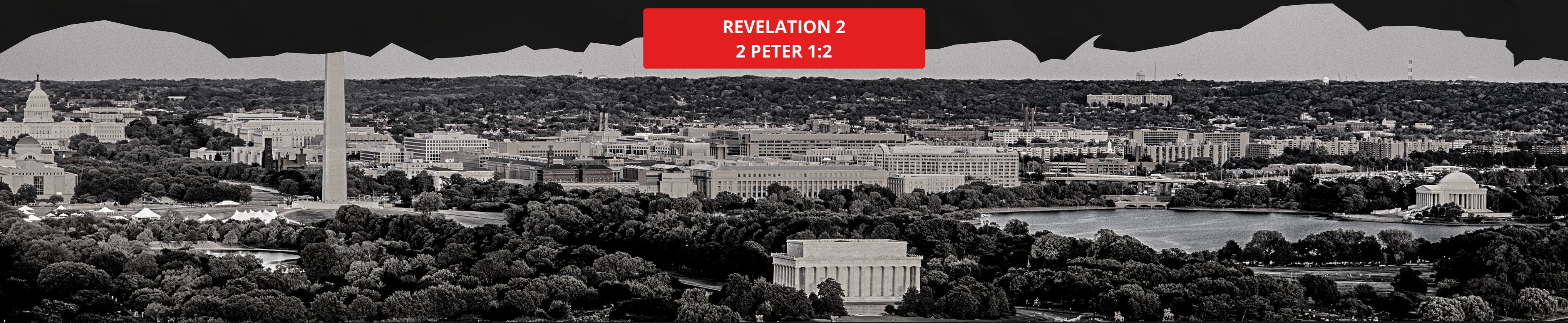

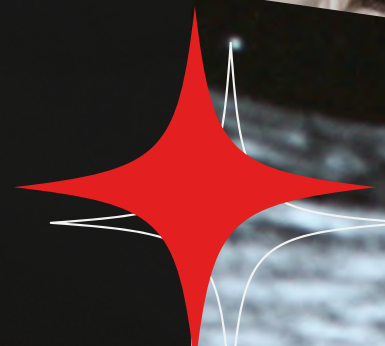
